GIFT AID FOR UK TAXPAYERS

Boost your donation by up to 25p of Gift Aid for every £1 you donate.

Gift Aid is reclaimed by the University from the tax you pay for the current tax year. Your address is needed to identify you as a current taxpayer.

HM Revenue and Customs current time limits and regulations outline that Gift Aid can be claimed on any giving **four years prior** and **six years after** the date of a signed Gift Aid Declaration.
